

Penner, seconded by Oswald to accept the bid of Hanson's Inc. of \$143,105.00. Roll call vote: Kirk Penner, Oswald, Wasem, Penner, Shaw, Paisley voting aye.

Motion by Oswald, seconded by Penner to accept the 2006-2007 School Year calendar as presented. Roll call vote: Oswald, Wasem, Penner, Shaw, Kirk Penner, Paisley voting aye.

Principals Standage and Carlson provided a power point presentation which explained the remodeling in portions of the Elementary School this summer; such remodeling would enable teachers currently located in the north modular to be moved into the main school building. In doing so, the modular would be vacated allowing it to be used to house two additional classes of kindergarten; thus, full day kindergarten could occur for the 2006-2007 school year.

Motion by Penner, seconded by Shaw to have full day kindergarten beginning with the 2006-2007 school year with the following provisions: (1) parents of kindergarten children would have the option to send their child to the full day program or a half day program; this provision would continue until such time full day kindergarten is mandated by the State; (2) the half day program would only be in the morning on an every day basis; (3) parents of kindergarten children would clearly be aware that certain portions of the curriculum will not be provided their child due to only half day attendance; (4) a parent of a kindergarten child who attends the half day program may enroll their child to a full day status only at the end of each grading quarter; (5) parents of a kindergarten child must indicate to the Elementary School administration during "Kindergarten Round-Up/Registration" of their intention to have their child attend kindergarten on a half day basis; (6) school District transportation will not be provided at the end of the half day for those children who attend the half day program. Roll call vote: Wasem, Penner, Shaw, Kirk Penner, Oswald, Paisley voting aye.

The principals gave their monthly report.

The Board discussed a packet of information provided them concerning professional negotiations.

Motion by Kirk Penner, seconded by Shaw to adjourn. All voting aye.
